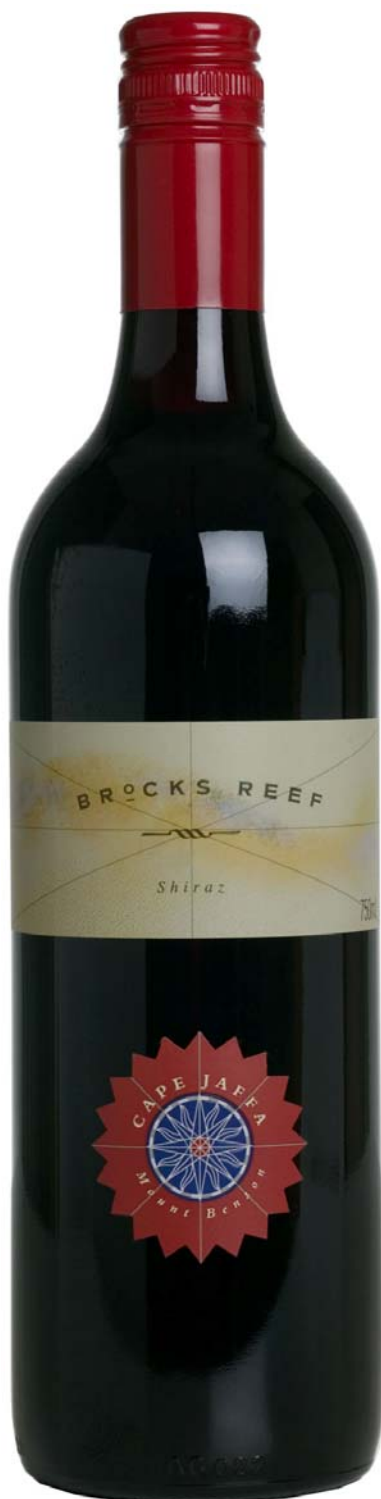


2006 Brocks Reef Shiraz



The Region

The Mount Benson Wine Region is a recently defined viticultural area situated 300km south of Adelaide on the Limestone Coast. Its key attributes for producing distinctive quality fruit include an abundance of underground water, *terra rossa* soil over free-draining limestone and a cool maritime climate. The region is renowned for producing elegant and complex wines.

Vintage

The dry 2006 growing season was an excellent one for Shiraz with moderate temperatures producing fruit which achieved the perfect balance between varietal aromas and ripe fruit characters.

Winemaking

Best parcels of fruit are selected from neighbouring vineyards across the Limestone Coast.

Winemaking

This wine is blended from some of our best parcels having gone through a combination of open and closed fermentation, followed by ageing in French oak.
