

2008 Brocks Reef Semillon Sauvignon Blanc



The Region

The Mount Benson Wine Region is a recently defined viticultural area situated 300km south of Adelaide on the Limestone Coast. Its key attributes for producing distinctive quality fruit include an abundance of underground water, *terra rossa* soil over free-draining limestone and a cool maritime climate. The region is renowned for producing elegant and complex wines.

Vineyards

Fruit for our Brocks Reef label is sourced from a selection of premium vineyards across the Limestone Coast and Mount Benson wine regions.

Vintage

The Limestone Coast wine region experienced a vintage of extremes in 2008; record-breaking temperatures in March preceded a cooler-than-average February, allowing for gentle ripening across the region.

Winemaking

The winemaker's focus was on achieving the perfect balance between new world style ripe, tropical fruit and the traditional grassy characters that are typical of these two classic Bordeaux varieties. Produced using gentle and meticulous winemaking techniques, a small portion of barrel-fermented sauvignon blanc adds structure and ageing potential to the blend.
